Boys' jackets have the leather sleeves and cost \$169. They charge \$6 to embroider the name over the left chest.

K & L sell the graduating year, such as "10", "11" and will sew any emblem onto the jacket for an additional \$4. Or you can sew it on yourself.

The Booster Club has several of the "St. John Hornets" chenille emblems that the boys usually add onto the back. They are \$24. Call Jill Arbeiter if you need this item.

To order a jacket, call K & L at 573-547-5220. To guarantee arrival by Christmas, orders should be placed by the end of October. The Booster Club will pick item up and deliver them to the school when they arrive. They need an order of at least 6 jackets to guarantee that price.
