PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION

St. John will be holding their preschool registration for the 2009-2010 school year beginning the week of February 23-27. We will again be offering an Extended Care Program. Class sessions for the 3 year-old program will be 8:15 – 11:15 a.m. and the 4 year-old session 11:00 a.m. – 2:45 p.m. Students wishing to enroll must have reached the age of 3 for the three-year-old and 4 for the four-year-old before September 1, 2009.
